Jamestown residents, property and business owners:

The Village of Jamestown income tax rate will increase to 1% effective January 1, 2025 on wages, net profit and other compensation. The current .5% rate has been in effect since 1987.

If you work within the Village of Jamestown limits, employers are required to withhold the tax. Employers have been notified of the change, but you should check with the payroll department to verify they received the notice.

Also effective January 1, 2025, the full (100%) credit for tax paid to other municipalities will be decreased to 50%. This means that if you work in a municipality that has their own income tax, you will also pay one-half of one percent (.5%) to Jamestown. Previously if you paid tax to another city, the Jamestown tax was waived. Many employers outside the village limits will withhold the tax for you as a courtesy. Please check with the payroll department to request this. If your employer isn't able to withhold the tax for you, estimated tax vouchers are included with the 2024 income tax return for you to make quarterly payments.

If you have no tax liability, you are exempt from mandatory filing if you complete the exemption form included with the 2024 tax return. Income that is not taxable include: active military pay, social security benefits, disability, interest/dividends, unemployment, pensions, retirement benefit payments, railroad retirement benefits, alimony and child support payments.
